Background to GrindingHub in Stuttgart

GrindingHub will be held in Stuttgart for the third time from 5 to 8 May 2026. The trade fair is staged every two years by the VDW (German Machine Tool Builders' Association), Frankfurt am Main, in cooperation with Messe Stuttgart and Swissmen (Association of the Swiss Mechanical Engineering, Electrical Engineering and Metal Industry) as the promotional supporter in the industrial sector of machine tools. In 2024 around 500 exhibitors from 31 countries attracted more than 11,100 visitors to their stands. Grinding technology is one of the top 3 production processes in the machine tool industry in Germany. According to official statistics, the industry produced machines to the value of €1.1 billion in 2024. Approximately 80 per cent of these machines were exported, around 40% of which to Europe. The largest sales markets are China, the USA, and India. In addition to Germany, the world ranking list includes China, the USA, Japan, and Switzerland. In 2024 the grinding technology industry produced machines to the value of approximately €5.5 billion worldwide.
